SECTION 4. FIRST-AID MEASURES

4.1 Description of first aid measures

- Ingestion* : Do NOT induce vomiting. Never give anything by mouth to a person who is unconscious or is having convulsions. If irritation or symptoms develop, seek medical attention.

5.1 Extinguishing media

Suitable extinguishing media
